





Assembly Instructions

Tools Required: Phillips Screwdriver, Rubber Mallet, or Padded Hammer and a Pencil



To move the adjustable shelves:

- 1. Determine where you want to place the Adjustable Shelves (A). Remove the #6 x 1/2" Undercut Screw (C) from the underside of the shelf and take out the Shelf and Shelf Brackets (B). Insert the Shelf Brackets (flat side down) into the four different holes and insert the shelf. You may secure them by inserting #6 x 1/2" Undercut screws. See Figure 1a
- 2. Place the bookcase in your desired location. Level the unit using the Adjustable Glides (I) located on the bottom of the bookcase. See Figure 1.
